You may submit digital images only!

Digital photos should be no less than 1280 x 960 pixels (minimum 1MB in size) and may be submitted on-line to:

JUDGING

A jury of professionals from various areas in the field of horticulture will evaluate submitted projects. All judges are members of LOWC.

Judges will determine quality of materials (both plant materials and hardscape), design, completeness of installation, workmanship and horticultural correctness. The judges' decisions are final.

ENTRY DEADLINE

All entries must be postmarked by August 31, 2010. Recipients will be honoured and their awards presented during an awards ceremony to be held in November. Location and time to be announced at a later date.

- 1. Complete the attached entry form.
- 2. On an attached page, provide a general description of property/project, any special features and any unusual site problems encountered. Include the address of the site. For landscape construction entries, include the duration of the project, completion date and the name of the designer.

Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards will be givenout in the following seven categories.

Landscape Maintenance - Commercial Turf and garden areas of property under contract will be considered.

Landscape Maintenance - Residential Turf and garden areas of property under contract will be considered.

Landscape Construction - Large Commercial (over \$10,000) New landscape construction or significant renovation of complete commercial property. Quality of design, materials and construction will be considered.

Landscape Construction - Small Commercial (under \$10,000) New landscape construction or significant renovation of specific area of a commercial property. Quality of design, materials and construction will be considered.

Landscape Construction - Large Residential (over \$25,000) New landscape construction or significant renovation of complete residential property. Quality of design, materials and construction will be considered.

Landscape Construction - Small Residential (under \$25,000) New landscape construction or significant renovation of specific area of a residential property. Quality of design, materials and construction will be considered. Example: foundation planting, pool area, or sitting area.

Landscape Construction - Water Feature New construction or significant renovation of pond, waterfall, or fountain.

Quality of design, materials and construction will be considered.
