ENTRY GUIDELINES

- Only Landscape Ontario members are eligible to enter plant material
- There is no entry fee

AWARD CATEGORIES:

1. Evergreens – Field Grown, Upright and Spreading
2. Evergreens – Container Grown, Upright and Spreading
3. Broadleaf Evergreens
4. Deciduous Shrubs
5. Deciduous Ornamental Trees – 300 cm or less
6. Deciduous Ornamental Trees – Top Grafted/Worked
7. Caliper Trees (Minimum of two specimens)
8. Vines and Groundcovers
9. Perennials
10. Unusual and Rare Plants (Worthy of attention, minimum of four specimens)
11. Design on a Skid — be creative, anything goes (as long as it fits on a skid!)

Judges Choice Award: The judges will choose the best overall entry to receive this special award.

PLANT MATERIAL GUIDELINES

NOTE: All plant material entered will be auctioned off

- Plant material must be Ontario-grown at your nursery for at least one year.
- Plant material should be finished and retail-ready (eg: for sale to a garden centre)
- Ensure the material is the correct size and type for the category entered and there are at least five of each size and type
- Sizes of plant material should be in metric units
- EACH skid of plant material entered for judging must have a skid form filled out. Use correct botanical nomenclature
- All plant material must be identified by botanical name as well as common name
- Finished sizes must be noted in metric units and sized according to the *Canadian Standards of Nursery Stock* (7th Edition) available from Canadian Nursery Landscape Association (CNLA)
- Plant types may be mixed on a pallet as long as there are a minimum of five per type (exceptions are Category 7, two specimens only and Category 10, four specimens only).

JUDGING CRITERIA

New Introductions: Interesting and exciting but it is the quality of the individual specimens and uniformity of the lot that matters most.

Plant Health: Nutrition and freedom from pests and diseases
Presentation: Impact of the plant material on the skid. Skids packed full have a very striking appearance

Quality of Plant Material: Uniformity in growth and habit, colour, lushness and density of growth

Recent Pruning: For shape is not favourable

Root Development: Judges do remove the pots and examine the root system. Marks are taken off where root balls fall apart (suggesting overwatering, recent potting or poor management practices)

Tree Guards: Please remove prior to judging. Judges examine the bark.

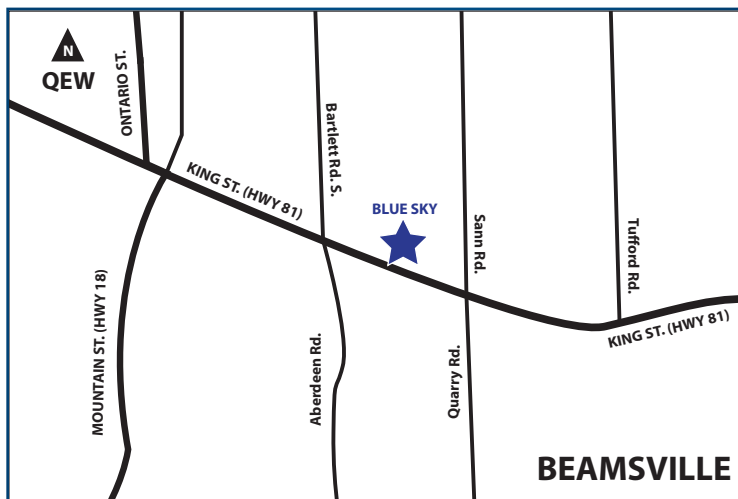
Awards will be given only to those entries worthy of attention as determined by the judges. All decisions are final.

Winners are not eligible to enter the same plant variety in the same category for two years; plants may be re-entered in the third year

NOTE: A skid form must be filled out for EACH skid of plant material entered for judging (will be mailed to you, if you fax in page #)

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

- Winners will be announced at the end of the auction
- A formal recognition ceremony will be held in conjunction with the Garden Centre Breakfast Event on October 19, 2011 during Expo at the Toronto Congress Centre
